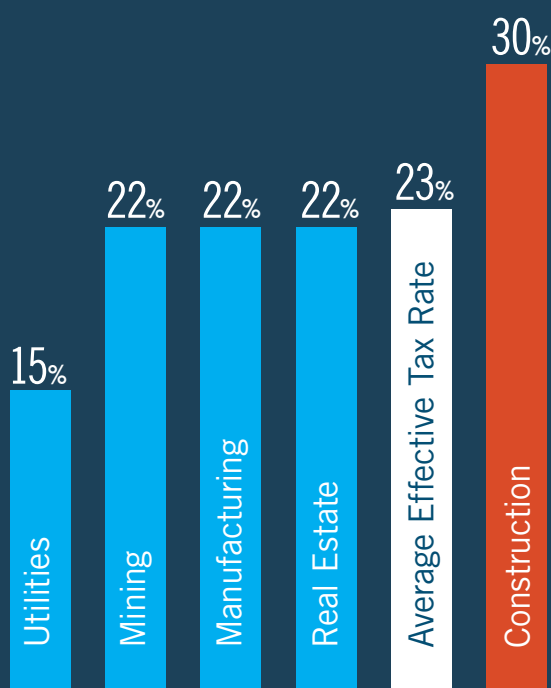

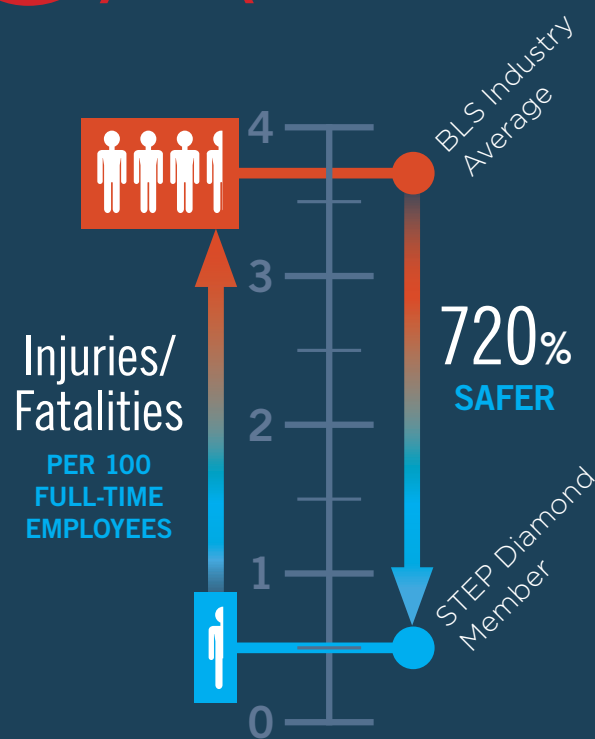

The construction industry historically pays the highest effective federal tax rate of any industry in the U.S. economy.

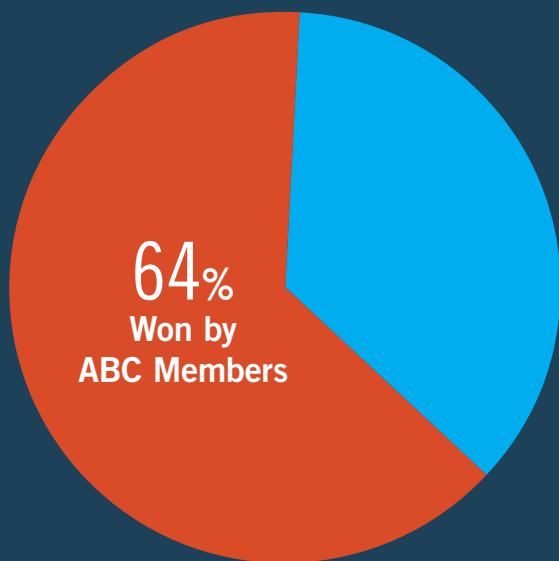
Treasury Department Effective Actual Corporate Tax Rates by Industry for 2007-2010

Member companies that achieve the highest level of performance in ABC's safety program are 720 percent safer than the BLS industry average.*

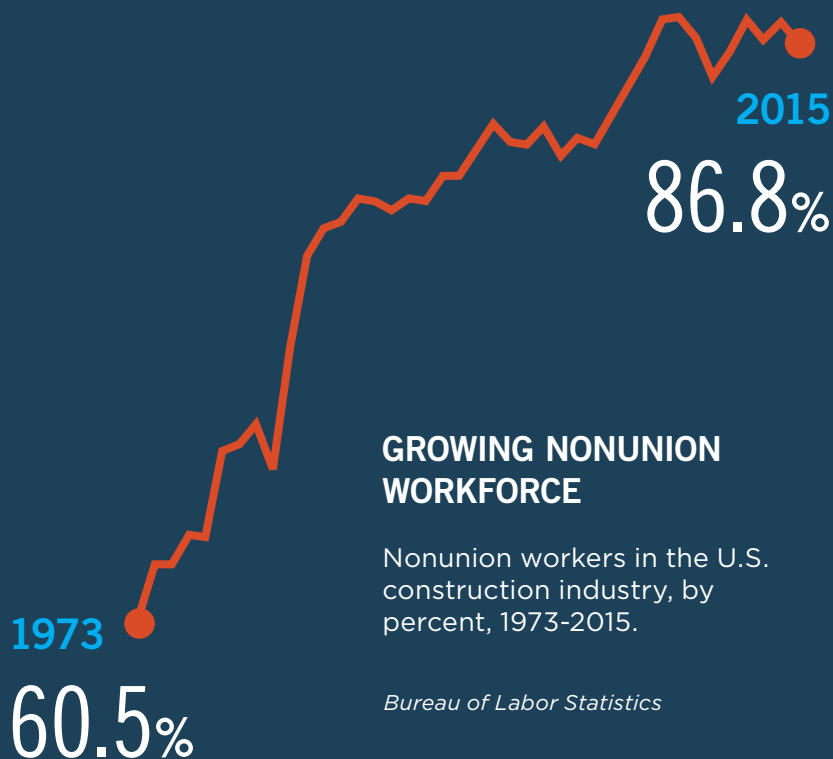

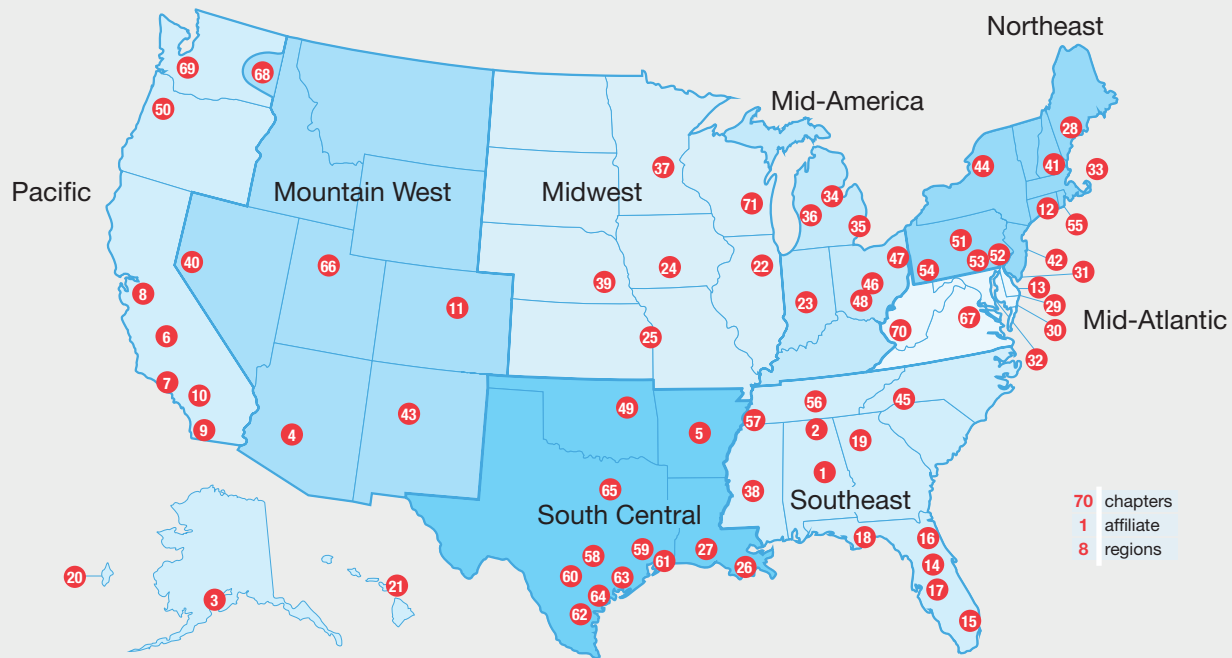

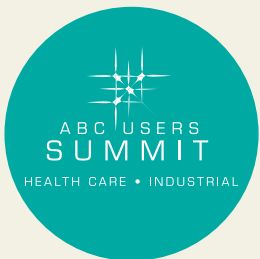
